- **Accountability** - Submit assignments on time with your best work
- **Honesty** - Have a high level of academic integrity. Complete and submit your own work.
- **Appropriateness** - Follow the dress code and other school rules outlined in the student handbook
- **Wellness** - Follow established health and safety protocols
- **Community** - Be kind and be patient with yourself, your teachers, and your peers
- **Self-Care** - If you are stressed, overwhelmed, or hurting, seek help immediately

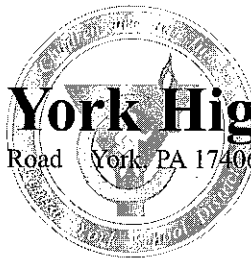
### Important Upcoming Events:

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
