

Algebra 2 Quiz/Unit Test Repair Policy

Step #1

Homework grade is 70% or better for the unit of the test.

- a. Homework is graded at the beginning of the period. The grade is either "Done" (2points) or "Not Done" (0 points).
- b. A "Not Done" (0 points) from an assignment can be upgraded to "Done/2" (1 point) if it is shown at the beginning of the period the school day after it was originally due.

If Step #1 is satisfied, then you may move to Step #2. Otherwise you can NOT repair the Quiz/Unit Test.

Step #2

Repair the Quiz/Unit Test to 100%.

- a. All problems needing repair are to be solved showing all work for each problem on a separate piece of paper. Do NOT change anything on the original test.
- b. The repair work is to be stapled behind the original test and finished within one six day cycle starting the day the original test is returned.

Once Step #2 is verified by a teacher, grade changes are as follows:

- a. Original test scores below 50% are changed to 50%.
- b. Original test scores 50% and above will have 10% of the points they missed (minimum 1pt) added to the original score.

If the repair is NOT verified, you can continue to repair the test within the six day cycle.

Step #3

Re-Test of Quiz/Unit Test if repaired grade is below 70%.

- a. Re-Tests are to be taken during ACP. The Re-Test will be concentrated on the main concepts and skills.
- b. The maximum possible grade is 70% even if the Re-Test is greater than 70%.
- c. The Re-Test grade will be your new grade (max 70%) even if it is lower than the original/repaired grade.
- d. Only one re-test is allowed per Quiz/Unit Test.
