## National Honor Society Future Members Information Session

#### What is NHS?

- National Organization founded on recognizing students for their scholarship, leadership, service, and character
- Purpose of chapter: Recognize members of CYHS student body with enthusiasm for the "pillars" above
- Seek to promote characteristics both in Members and Nonmembers in the school community

## How do I qualify to join NHS?

- Any rising juniors or seniors who have completed at least 1 semester at CYHS and demonstrate the qualities of character, scholarship, leadership, and service
- See NHS Prospective Membership Requirements, on back
- Any student whose GPA qualifies them for membership will receive information during the summer prior to their junior and/or senior year and will be added to a Cyhs Potential Nhs Members Schoology course

## What do I do after I find out I can join NHS?

- View the Schoology course for potential members
- Complete Prospective Membership Paperwork; this will require you to obtain references for your leadership, service, and character via Google Forms, and to write a short personal essay

#### What will I do as a member of NHS?

- Members will attend an Induction Ceremony, along with a practice, in the Fall semester
- Meet once per month
- Obtain fifteen or more hours of service in the school and community per semester (a total of 30 hours or more per year)
- Maintain high academic and personal integrity
- Develop and/or participate in a chapter-wide service project

## What will I get out of NHS?

- Opportunities to expand on your leadership
- Opportunities to be involved in the school and community
- Network opportunities and additional scholarship opportunities through the national organization
- Recognition for your dedication, including at the Induction Ceremony and with a stole at graduation
- The ability to include a nationally-recognized organization on your college and/or career applications

The purpose of this document is to assist prospective members when completing the student information form.

<u>Character:</u>
The student of good character is cooperative; demonstrates high standards of honesty and reliability;
shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others; and generally maintains a clean disciplinary record.

☐ No reports of academic dishonesty
*Two teachers must complete a form attesting to your character (as listed on your Student
Activity Information Form)
Scholarship:
☐ 3.65 Cumulative weighted GPA
☐ Taken at least one (1) Honors or AP- level course per year
☐ Completed at least four (4) Honors or AP- level courses during high school career
☐ No reports of academic dishonesty
Leadership:
Student leaders are those who are resourceful, good problem solvers, and idea contributors. Leadership experiences can be drawn from school or community activities while working with or for others.
*One adult supervisor must complete a form attesting to your leadership (as listed on your Student
Activity Information Form)
Service:
Any time spent assisting others without receiving compensation, monetary or otherwise.
☐ Must have an <u>average</u> of at least twenty (20) hours of documented service per year from the
start of high school to application date
☐ An average of at least five hours per year must be conducted within the community
☐ An average of at least five hours per year must be conducted within the school
☐ To document hours, include the name and telephone number of a person in charge (cannot be
a relative)
*One adult supervisor must complete a form attesting to your service within the community (as listed
on your Student Activity Information Form)
